

Worksheet – Finding Data Task (10 mins)

Go to the UK Data Service homepage: <u>https://ukdataservice.ac.uk/</u>.

Part 1: Browsing data

Go to our Data Catalogue (<u>https://ukdataservice.ac.uk/find-data/</u>) and, using the browsing facets on the left-hand side, try to refine your search for qualitative data specifically. Then, narrow your search further to see datasets collected in the past 10 years.

Part 2: Finding data on a topic

Head to the find data page (<u>https://ukdataservice.ac.uk/find-data/browse/</u>), here you can search by theme and data type. Using the search bar at the top, start searching keywords to find data that might be relevant for your own research. If you don't have set topic, you can have a go searching for data that might help you answer questions on:

- a. How people feel about the police and justice system
- b. The impact of covid-19 on young people
- c. Exploring people's shopping habits
- d. Children's use of the internet
