



Series and study records

- Series page
 - Information about survey in general (answers to FAQs)
 - Links to all studies from the series
- Study records
 - Abstract and study details
 - Access to data and documentation for the particular study



Licenses: EUL and Safe Room

EUL

- Safeguarded: not personal data, but a risk of disclosure
- Fewer and less detailed variables than secure access

Safe Room access

- •Additional variables e.g. detailed geography and Nationality and Date of birth
- Unrounded data
- •HBAI and Pensioner's Income
- Additional checks, cannot download



Accessing Safe Room data

Determine your need and feasibility of the project Use the FUI • Identify what is in the Safe Room version you need (use data dictionaries) **Application forms** • Research Proposal - demonstrate why you need access to the extra, more detailed variables ESRC Accredited researcher form Security check and User agreements **Training** Access data in a safe environment (Safe Room, SecureLab) Outputs subject to checks
