Go to the <u>UK Data Service homepage</u>

Part 1: Browsing data

Go to our <u>Data Catalogue</u> and, using the browsing facets on the left-hand side, try to refine your search for qualitative data specifically. Then, narrow your search further to see datasets collected in the past 10 years.

Part 2: Finding data on a topic

Head to the <u>find data page</u>, here you can search by theme and data type. You can start to look for data that might be relevant for your own research, or if you don't have set topic, you can have a go searching for data that might help you answer questions on:

- a. How people feel about the police and justice system
- b. The mental health of young people
- c. Diet and nutrition

Or you could practice searching for one of the following datasets:

- a. The English Longitudinal Study of Ageing: Waves 0-10, 1998-2023
- b. The latest edition of the British Social Attitudes Survey
- c. The Living Costs and Food Survey, 2017-2018
