You can't get a Corby person down. If you present them with a problem, they are going to find a way to get through that and probably won't be doing it by themselves. They'll probably know five different people that can help you with that problem. That is what a Corby person is. That is the pool, I suppose.



Wellingborough and Kettering, when I was younger, were a lot better than Corby. Or so my perception of it was, people from those towns saying, "Corby's a shithole and whatever ...



The town had a terrible reputation. If you'd say, 'Oh I'm going to Corby', they would say things like, 'Oh, I wouldn't take your car, or ... I'd get somebody to guard your car, or I wouldn't go after dark', and that drove me bonkers.



Community Wealth

Based on our research of communities across England, we have built two indexes to understand community wealth in local authority districts.

The Funding & Affluence Metric (FAM) shows charitable, philanthropic & public spending, and IMD scores.

The Community Strength Index (CSI) shows the strength of community ties and community ownership of resources.

Community Strength Index




Map view: 2D with location () 3D




