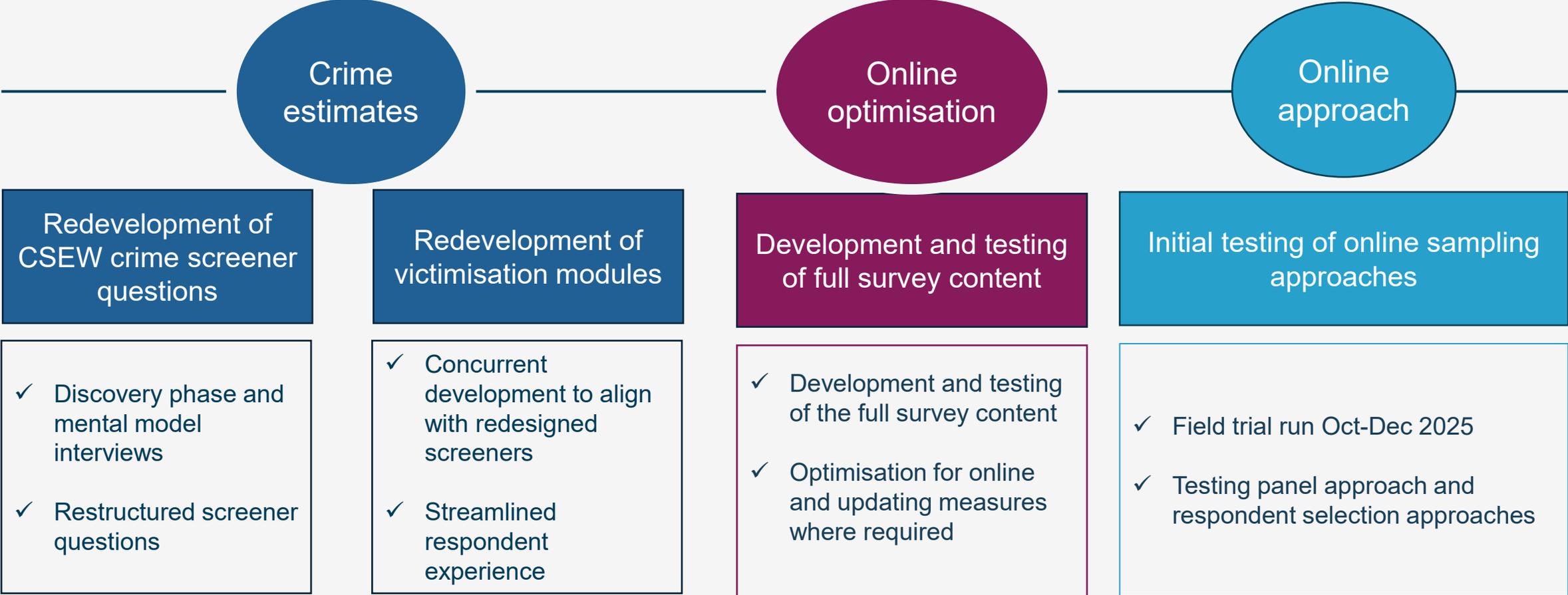

# CSEW Online Development

Crime estimates

## Redevelopment of CSEW crime screener questions

- ✓ Discovery phase and mental model interviews
- ✓ Restructured screener questions

## Redevelopment of victimisation modules

- ✓ Concurrent development to align with redesigned screeners
- ✓ Streamlined respondent experience

## Redeveloped approach

### Screener questions

- ✓ Aims to capture main features of incidents within the screener questions
- ✓ Streamlines experience for survey participants
- ✓ Phase 1 testing in progress

### Victimisation module

- ✓ Designed by ONS and Verian to utilise additional information captured through screeners
- ✓ Twenty cognitive interviews conducted so far to test and iterate development

# Example (Burglary)

- **Incident description:** Somebody broke into respondent's home by forcing open the back door. They stole jewellery, car keys and electrical goods. They also stole the car from the front drive using the stolen keys.

# CSEW Online Development

## Online optimisation

### Development and testing of full survey content

- ✓ Development and testing of the full survey content
- ✓ Optimisation for online and updating measures where required

## Full Survey Optimisation (excluding Domestic Abuse and Sexual Assault modules)

### Stakeholder review

- ✓ Drawing on 2022 Consultation responses
- ✓ Further review with Home Office and Ministry of Justice to prioritise requirements

### Questionnaire review

- ✓ Conducted with Verian
- ✓ Modules redrafted to optimise online completion experience

### Cognitive and cogability testing (Verian)

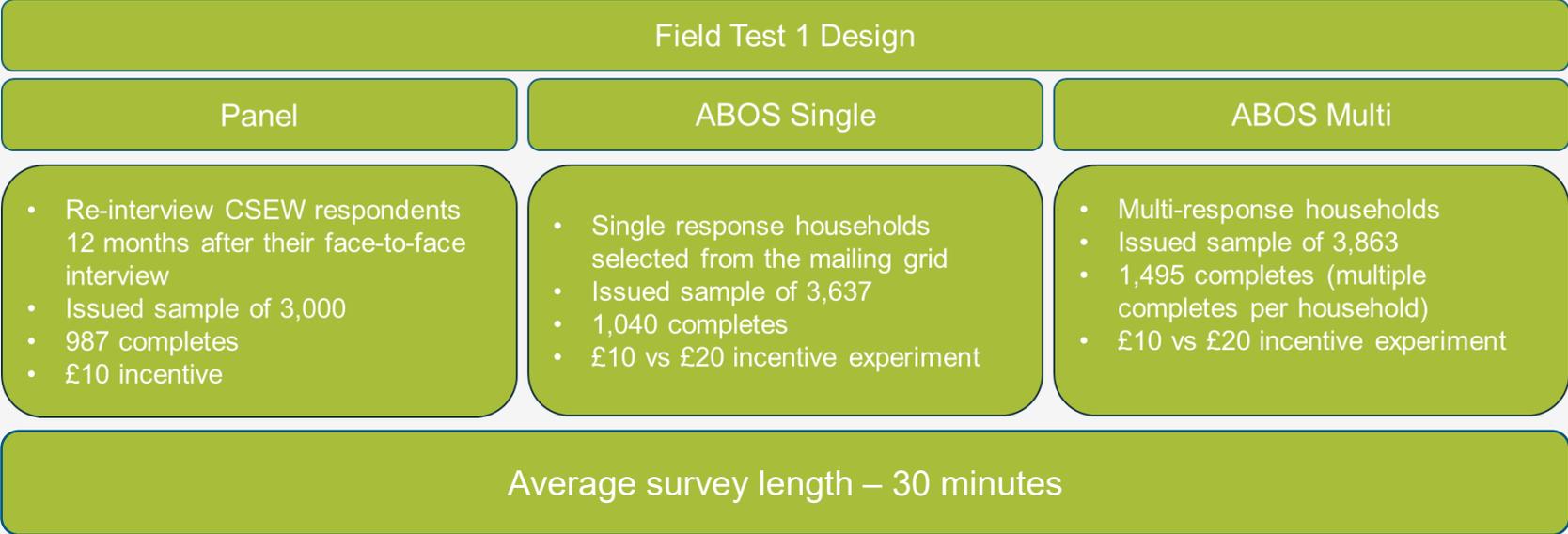
- ✓ Four rounds of cognitive/cogability testing completed
- ✓ Iterative design between rounds

# CSEW Online Development

Online approach

Initial testing of online sampling approaches

- ✓ Field trial run Oct-Dec 2025
- ✓ Testing panel approach and respondent selection approaches

- Continued focus on development and testing of screener and victimisation modules.
- Larger scale feasibility test (tbc)
