



## How to get here

The Administrative Data Research Centre Scotland is based in the Edinburgh Bioquarter, 9 Little France Road, EH16 4UX

### If arriving at Edinburgh airport:

#### 1) Airlink bus #100

Express bus service from the airport to Waverley Bridge (arriving near Princes Street and the main rail / bus stations)

Buy tickets at the airport information desk, or at the bus stop, or from the driver or in advance online

Frequency: Every 10 minutes.

Journey time: about 30 minutes (to Waverley Bridge). Then follow directions from Waverley station (below).

2) Alternative: taxi from the airport. Cost £25 - £30 (approx.)

A journey to the city centre typically takes about 25 minutes. Travelling to ADRC directly from the airport takes about 30mins, depending on traffic.

### If arriving at Waverley train station:

Walk to North Bridge and take any of the following buses travelling south: #49, #33 or the #8 to the Royal Infirmary.

Journey time: about 30 minutes.

#### Finding us at 9 Bioquarter:

Disembark from bus at 'Royal Infirmary' stop.

Walk away from the hospital (building 7 on map 1), towards Little France Drive, going to the left (north eastern side) of the MRC Centre for Regenerative Medicine (building 4 on the map 1). Follow the dotted pink pathway suggested on map 2 in order to avoid the construction site. We are on the 2nd floor of Number 9, through the wooden main door to the left when you arrive in the  $2^{nd}$  floor lobby the elevators/stairwell.
